
THE WOLFF SISTERS - DARK RIVER

The wait for a new Wolff Sisters album is over. Three years since their last album release, The Wolff Sisters present their fourth studio album, 'Dark River', on September 9th across all streaming platforms. Recorded at Dimension Sound Studios and The Bridge Sound and Stage, 'Dark River' dives deeper into their signature Americana/Folk-Rock storytelling and sound. The 7-song collection of original work produced by Dan Cardinal also features an array of talented local guest musicians throughout the album including Luke Mallett of The Mallett Brothers Band, Cody Nilsen of Ward Hayden & The Outliers, Chris Bloniarz of Honeysuckle, Nick Mercado of These Wild Plains, and the late Nick Iddon of The Quahogs.

There's a song and story for everyone on the new album, from the title track 'Dark River' - a hypnotic swamp boogie evoking the sounds of Little Feat, to the anthemic 'Boston Town' - an ode to their roots - and tales of a small town succumbing to climate change and greedy industrialization in 'Sing Me Back, Springsteen'.

The Wolff Sisters is fronted by Rebecca on acoustic guitar, Kat on the keys, and Rachael on electric guitar. They are, yes, real sisters and all trade off singing lead vocals and harmonies. The sisters crafted their sound around a honky tonk piano in the living room of their childhood home. With Ryan Curless on the drums and Caleb Sweet on the bass, The Wolff Sisters have worked tirelessly to hone their sound and build up a following across New England and beyond.

The Wolff Sisters have been named New England Music Awards Americana Act of the Year 2021 and Boston Music Awards Americana Act of The Year 2020. The band's electrifying live performance and unique sound has received recognition through publications like The Boston Globe, Red Line Roots, Americana UK, and more. Their highly anticipated album release show will be on September 9th, 2022 at The Fallout Shelter in Norwood, MA.
